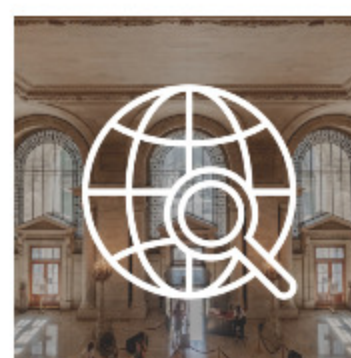

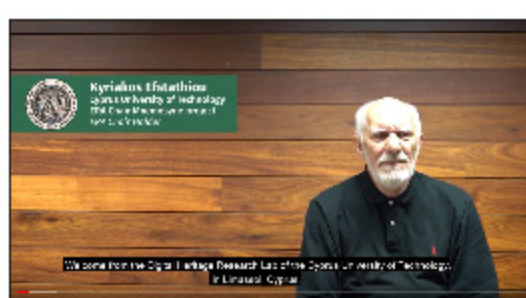

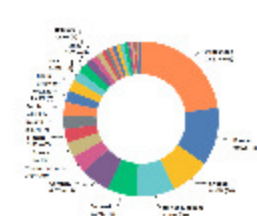

The Impact of Covid-19 on Research Libraries Across Europe

LIBER (Ligue des Bibliothèques Européennes de Recherche – Association of European Research Libraries) sent out a survey to all research libraries across Europe during the last months of 2020 to address the overall effects COVID-19 has had on research libraries thus far. It also aimed to outline the current situation within research libraries as far as the maintaining/building of library services is concerned during Covid.

LIBER says "As we move towards a post-pandemic reconstruction of the library and scholarly information landscape, we believe that collaboration across the European library network will be fundamental."
